

NiceCash is an online financial platform with its own virtual currency.

Selling and buying products, offering and taking one-time jobs, without the hassle[®].

Now with bitcoin support!

If you're new to NiceCash, it's recommended to read this.

NiceCash's own virtual currency is NiceCoin, its approximate value (1) is 28HUF/0.07EUR/0.08USD You can preview NiceCash by clicking preview in the login window.

Register using the register link in the login window.

Note that the following characters aren't supported in usernames: ,V.:*?'"<>|

And usernames are CaSe-SeNsItIvE, meaning that it will save the case-format of your username, but both 'Tim82' and 'tim82' cannot exist.

Having multiple user accounts is prohibited.

The UI is primarily designed for desktop users, but it can also be used on mobile devices.

After you used NiceCash, you can log-off by clicking on your username in the bottom-left corner→Log Out

On this platform, there are no fees or taxes for anything! You only pay for what you buy.
Well... except for bitcoin, because NiceCash has to pay transaction fees to work. [Learn more]

Sell:

- Here you can sell products.
- You can also specify conditions. We recommend using the conditions editor.
- You can upload a PNG or JP(E)G image for your product (or job) with a maximum size of 3MB / 2000x2000.
- Any shipping fees must be included in the price.

- When someone buys your product, you will get a message that you should serve the product to the buyer.
- To know where to serve your product, use the contact information checker.
- There's no delivery service associated with NiceCash, every seller has to ship with their own delivery method. (e.g. Delivering personally, or via a delivery service)
- You should always update packaging and delivery progress through the Businesses tab.

Store:

- · Here you can buy products.
- Double click a product to buy it.
- Right click on product → "Use coupon" if you have a coupon.
- To view images double click them.
- To download images right click or long tap them.
- When you buy a product, the seller will receive a message that XYZ bought his/her product and (s)he should serve it to you.
- After a while you will get the product which you bought. (You can track it in the businesses tab.)
- If you get a message about that the product has arrived, but in reality, it didn't arrive, then note the username of the seller and contact support.

Offer a job:

- Here you can offer one-time jobs.
- When you offer the job, the salary amount will be deducted from your balance.
- If someone takes your job, the amount you paid for offering the job goes to the worker.
- You can view the job's status in the businesses tab.

Jobs:

- Here you can search and take one-time jobs.
- Double click to take.
- Always update progress in businesses tab.

Contact information checker:

- Here you can check users' contact information by entering a username.
- This is for knowing where to serve your product.
- You can also check for bitcoin addresses, if you want to send bitcoin to someone manually.

Manage products, Manage jobs:

- Here you can manage your products or jobs.
- Right click an item for a list of options.

Businesses:

- The products' and jobs' status viewer/manager.
- If you buy a product, you'll see it here when it will arrive.
- If someone takes your job, you see it here when it will be done.
- As a seller (If someone bought your product.) you must keep information about the shipping up-to-date here.
- As a worker (If you took a job.) you must keep information up-to-date here about when the job will be done.
- Click on the business to view the Product/Job's Name/Description
- If it turns out that you can't do the job for some reason, then you can cancel the job with RMB→Cancel business
- As a seller, if you want to reject an order, then right click on business → Cancel business
- Increase progress by RMB→Increase by X%
- If progress reaches 100%, or the checkbox gets checked, then the business will be marked done and will be closed.



Minigames:

- Here you can play minigames to win money. (Click to play)
- Daily luck is free forever, lottery costs money (NiceCoin).

Send cash:

- Here you can transfer money (NiceCoin) to another user's account. (There are no extra fees! ©)
- If you want to send Bitcoin to someone, then use the Contact information checker to get the address, then send it using any wallet software you use. (Though we recommend <u>Electrum</u>.)

Send a message:

• This is for simply sending messages without money.

Edit account:

- Here you can modify your (secondary) password, contact information, and bitcoin address.
- Secondary passwords are for allowing access for a trusted friend to your account without revealing your main password.
- To remove your secondary password, simply change it without entering anything.

Messages:

- Here you can view your messages.
- By default, this only displays unread messages, but you can view all your messages by clicking this button with RMB, or long-tapping it.
- Right click or long tap a message for options.

Conditions:

- Conditions are for restricting who can view and buy your products/jobs.
- Writing condition codes can be confusing, and also there's no point of writing it manually, so we recommend using the conditions editor.

Coupons:

- Here you can create coupons to provide discounts to your customers.
- There are many options here, just leave blank what you don't need.

Some tabs can be right clicked for more options.
